### School Management Committee (SMC) Meeting

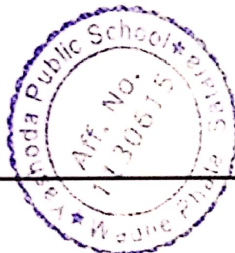
The first School Management Committee Meeting for the academic year 2025-26 was conducted on 5th April 2025 in the Seminar Hall.

Our tiny tots enthusiastically participated in:

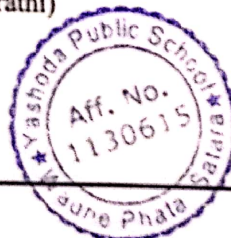
- Fancy Dress Competition

## Sports and Physical Education

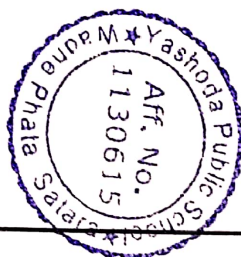
Sports activities were conducted throughout the year to develop sportsmanship, teamwork, discipline, and physical fitness among students.

- Capacity Building Programmes

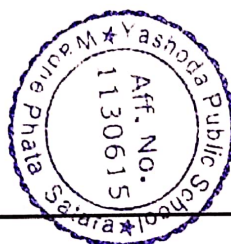
In-house workshops and seminars were also organized for teachers on innovative teaching methodologies, classroom management, digital learning, and student well-being.

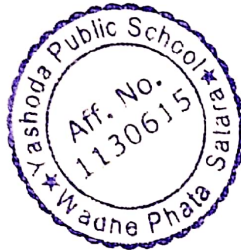
